

Expectations when you get a new cat



3 days

- Give the cat a safe territory with food, bedding, water, litter tray, toys for comfort, and hiding places
- The cat might want to hide all the time and might feel overwhelmed and scared.
- For the first 24 hours, the cat might not want to eat and drink, if this continues, be sure to try him/her on palatable wet cat food. and keep an eye.
- Only handle the cat if he/she initiates it.



3 weeks

- The cat feels more comfortable and starts to settle in
- Might start coming to you more often
- Starts showing his/her true personality
- Starts exploring his/her environment
- Behaviour issues might start appearing



3 months

- The cat feels now at home, is comfortable around the family, and is beginning to form a bond with you and the other humans in the house
- Him/her is adapted to the routine
- Behaviour issues (if any) start to slow down as you begin to understand your cat and have advice from professionals
